**Park Description:** Eagle Ridge Park is a 28-acre park, named for the eagle's nest next to Lundeen Parkway, includes extensive passive recreation areas with nature trails that wind through the wetland headwaters of Hubert and Eagle creeks. A portion of the site houses the City's new senior center. The City has completed a master plan for the park that includes plans to turn an existing barn into an interpretive center and incorporate an outdoor classroom to emphasize the natural setting.
