Arts Commission Opening

The City of Lake Stevens is seeking applicants for two vacancies on the Arts Commission. These vacancies are for two unexpired terms, both ending December 31, 2020. The City is engaged in significant programs and growth and is looking forward to working with the Arts Commission on major subarea planning as well as parks and other development throughout the City. The Arts Commission's focus is to advise the Mayor and Council regarding the acquisition and display of art in public places. The Arts Commission also promotes art in the community, including Music on the Lake and other events. Interested applicants must complete and submit an application to be considered for an interview by the Mayor. Applications are available on the City's web page or at City Hall.

General Information: The City of Lake Stevens is a non-charter code city operating under the mayor-council plan of government in accordance with the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 35A.12. The City has an elected mayor and seven council members. The seven Arts Commission members are nominated by the Mayor with approval of the Council for four-year terms. Successful candidates will be asked to complete a Washington State Patrol background check.

Eligibility to hold an Arts Commission position is set forth in Lake Stevens Municipal Code Section 2.29.020 as follows:

“ . . . The Mayor and Council may appoint a member who resides or owns property within the City or the City's Urban Growth Area . . . At least four (4) members shall be residents of the City.”

Meetings are held the second and fourth Wednesday of each month at 6:30 p.m. at the Visitor Information Center located inside Lundeen Park.
