REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION:

1. Bring **picture ID** and a utility bill with your city address on it.
All non-residents will be turned away.
2. **Trash must be sorted** (Shred It paper, metals, tires, junk).
Small items/yard waste must be bagged.
3. **Dried food items** will be accepted for the Lake Stevens Food Bank (this is not mandatory).

KNOW THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

SHRED-IT: (Keep separate from other trash items, no businesses please)

- No plastic or three ring binders

ALLIED WASTE:

- Trash (furniture, toys and debris, etc – *small items must be bagged*)
- **Metals - MUST BE SEPARATED FROM OTHER TRASH**
- **Yard Waste – MUST BE BAGGED, BOXED, OR BUNDLED**
- **Refrigerators/Freezers (anything with freon) - \$25 fee per item**

Household (kitchen-type) trash, bricks, rocks, concrete, sod, and dirt are not accepted at this dump site. Large landscaping materials such as logs, branches, etc. must be cut and bundled to vehicle size.

LES SCHWAB TIRE CENTER:

- Tires **must be off rims** and no larger than standard pickup size
- Limit of **10 tires** per household
- This is a one day drop off event. **Les Schwab will not be accepting tires on any other day or at any of their stores.**

HAZARDOUS WASTE

This year's event WILL NOT be accepting any hazardous waste products
