OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

Description of Proposal: The proposal is to construct a new odor control bio-filter to serve an existing treatment facility. The bio-filter will draw odorous air from the existing facilities and route the odors through the new bio-filter that will treat the odorous air emissions. The biofilter consists of moist woodchip media which is stacked above grade and gravel air plenum which is buried. The biofilters operation capacity is 12,269 cubic feet of air per minute and removes odors through a biological process. The air collection and distribution system consists of approximately 700 linear feet of ductwork piping and 588 square yards of biofilters, which will result in approximately 933 cubic yards of grading.
